For the avoidance of doubt **ALL** games, up to and including the Divisional Final, are now played on **FRIDAYS** at 6.00 p.m. unless otherwise agreed with your opponent. There is no need to contact your opponent unless trying to arrange an earlier start time or date which must be mutually agreed. It <u>CANNOT</u> be later than the scheduled date.

If you cannot play on the set date please have the courtesy to let your opponent know.

Please note that the only scorecard you will receive is for your first match. So, if you win, you will need to provide your own scorecard for all future games.

After finishing each game get your opponent to sign your card and then please either ring, text, WhatsApp or email the result to me ASAP that evening. If that is not possible, I <u>MUST</u> be notified no later than 10.00 a.m. the following morning.

As usual I will be aiming to update the draw within 24 hours of all your results being received and the onus will be on <u>you</u> to ascertain who and where you are playing in the next round by checking the website. However, if you are in any doubt, please feel free to contact me

At the time of writing it appears that there will be a scaled-down version of the County Handbook published which will also contain the "Competitors Register" listing all competitors & their contact numbers.

However, as usual, this will also be shown on the KCBA website along with all the draws & a list showing the dates of all the rounds, Competition Stewards and the venues of all the Divisional Finals.

To access all this information click on "County Competitions" tab and then the "Division One" link.

Thankfully it has been decided that the Competitors Register on the website will not be "password protected" this season.

Finally, you must be available for **ALL** rounds of the competition up to the Divisional Final on **5**th **July** and then County Quarter & Semi Finals which are on **21**st **July, both being at West Wickham BC.** Then the last two will compete at the County finals on **11**th **August at Birchington BC**.

You should not participate in earlier rounds knowing that you cannot play in the later stages.
