

Two Wood Competition 2023

The early rounds of this competition will be played off on one day, **Sunday 4th June, at West Wickham B.C.**

A draw has already been done which subdivides the total number of entries (42) into Sections 'A' & 'B' containing 21 players. You will be notified which Section you are in either by telephone, text or email before the season starts.

Two further draws will be done on the day based on those who turn up which will avoid any walkovers being given & therefore reduce any waiting around as much as possible. **So please have the courtesy to let me know if you know you will not be attending.**

Players in **Section 'A'** will be required to arrive at the club **NO LATER THAN 9.00 A.M.** to register & allow that draw to be done, allocate rinks & markers & get the games started no later than 9.30 A.M. **NOTE - Anyone arriving after 9.00 a.m. will not be included in the draw.**

If all 21 players in Section 'A' turn up on the day it is hoped that the final two games from that Section could be started by around 1.15 p.m.

Players who are in **Section 'B'** need to arrive at the club to register **NO LATER THAN 12.45 P.M.** so that the draw can take place get the first set of games from that section started at around 1.15 P.M. when play in Section 'A' is finishing. **NOTE – Again anyone arriving after 12.45 p.m. will not be included in the draw.**

Again, if everyone who has entered turns up, we would hope to have the final two games from this section finished by around 5.30 p.m.

The final two from each section will play in the Divisional Semi Final / Final at Blackheath & Greenwich B.C. on 21st & 28th June.

Please note that, apart from the first of the morning games, all other times on the day can only be approximate. We cannot legislate for the length of games or any inclement weather that may disrupt play. However, rest assured we will do our best to get all games underway as soon as we possibly can.

It is hoped that losing players will agree to mark a subsequent game because we cannot expect the host club to provide markers for a full 8 hours ! **If you are not prepared to do this you must let us know before play in your section starts.**

Depending on the successful running of the day we will consider making this a fixed event in the calendar for future years so please help to make it work.
